

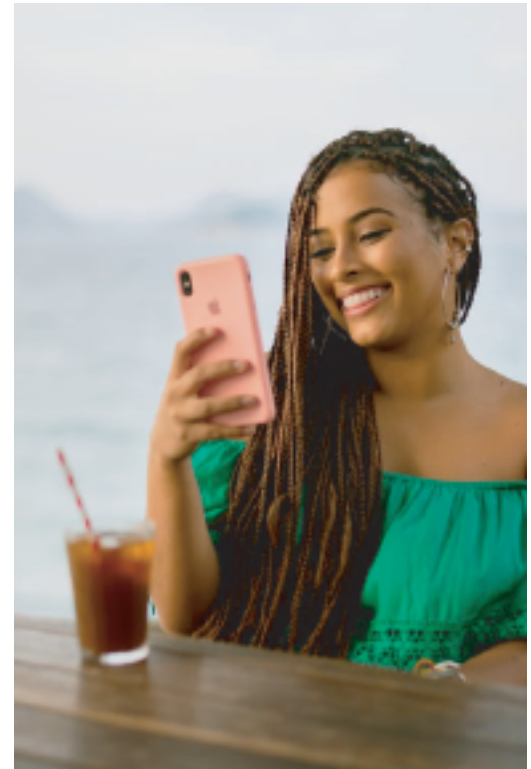

## GRAMMAR: VERB TO BE

### To be (infinitive)

I am Peter.  
You are not Susan.  
We are Peter and Susan.

### Structure:

Subject + to be (am are is) + complement

I am Susan  
You are Jack.  
He is John.  
We are professors.

### Examples:

It is Monday.  
Are we teachers?  
You are not Susan.
