

#### To be (infinitive)

I am Peter.

C. Canadian

You are not Susan.

We are Peter and Susan.

#### Structure:

Subject + to be (am are is) + com-

plement

I am Susan

You are Jack.

He is John.

We are professors.

#### **Examples:**

It is Monday.

Are we teachers?

You are not Susan.
