Language acquisition

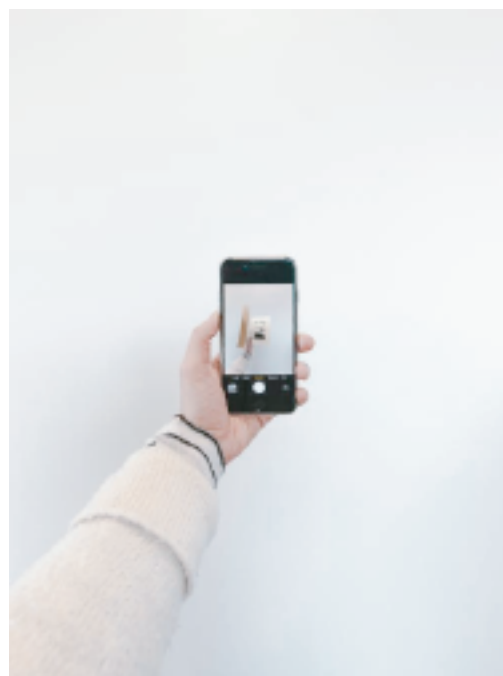
To learn a language
